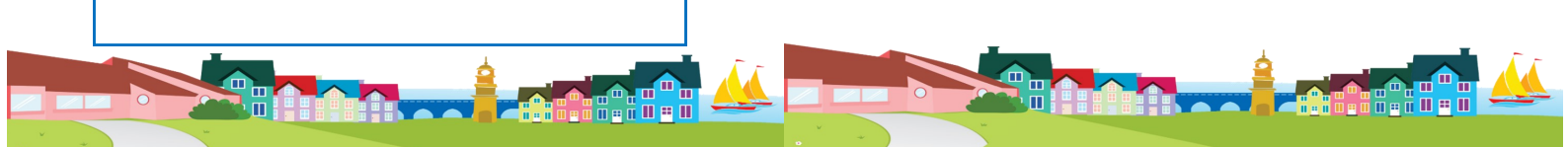

## Topic coverage (this may change during the term)

### English:

- We will be writing:
- Persuasive leaflets
- Publishing our letter (Day the crayons quit)

We will be going over reading strategies, focusing on meanings of words in context, and identifying key parts in a text to write summaries.

### Art and Design and Science:

- Exploring different mediums
- Children will be creating different electrical circuits and learning about the different elements.
- Children will be learning about Charles Darwin and his theory of evolution. Also, they will be exploring different habitats.

During Summer 2, Year 6 will be creating an enterprise activity, which will raise money for charity. They will have to work in a team to create a pitch for their idea and get it approved by Mr Hitchens. From here, they will collect data, plan,

### Mathematics:

Maths will be heavily linked towards our topic this half term. With Enterprise, the children will be collecting data, populating charts and working with a budget.

The children will be taking part in NatWest's math problems. These successful lessons give children a real life-context with maths. They focus on how to work out interest rates, best ways to save money and how to deal with money.

### PSHE:

The children will be following the whole school virtues

During the Summer term, we will be delivering SRE (sex, relationship education) to the children. During these sessions, the children will learn about relationships, puberty and the human body.

### RE:
