Clubs will run from Tuesday 8th June to Friday 16th July, from 3.15 - 4.15. Children will be collected from class by the club lead to attend their club.

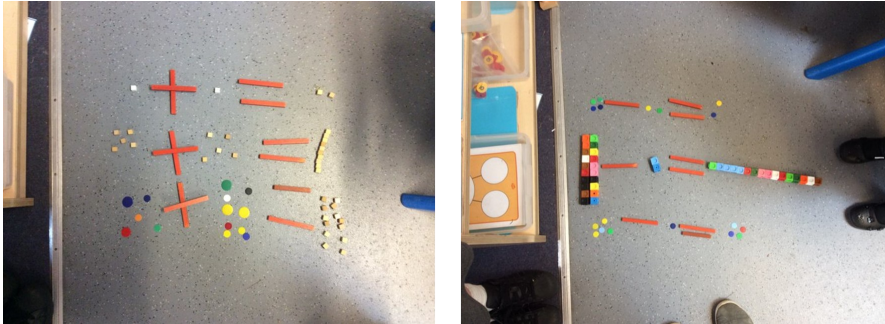
