We are pleased to offer your child a full time place in Nursery from September 2020. Attached is an information sheet that explains the cost implications of the full time offer for families who are not eligible for the Nursery Education Grant.

This letter would usually have information with dates for a Welcome to Nursery meeting and a Stay & Play session, but due to the circumstances we find ourselves in, we are currently unable to plan these dates in. However, we are constantly reviewing this in light of information from the government. Please check the website regularly, as we will keep it updated with the latest developments.

Regarding the home visits that usually take place before your child starts Nursery; this year it is likely that we will replace these with virtual meetings via FaceTime (or other online platform) with one of our Early Years team. Members of the team will contact families via phone in the first instance to arrange a meeting date. In the phone call, we will be able to give you more information regarding the best way to hold a virtual meeting with you. If you do not have the facilities or desire to have a virtual meeting, then we will be able to arrange a phone conversation.

There will be more information and documents for you to complete in due course but we for now, please complete and **return the acceptance slip** to confirm whether you would like the Nursery place or if you wish to withdraw your application. Due to social distancing, visits to the school office are not possible so we request that you either post the reply or send it via email to eyfs@salusbury.brent.sch.uk by **Friday, 1st May 2020**.

It is such a shame that we find ourselves in these strange times when your child preparing to start school. Please be assured that we are working very hard to organise the best possible start for them. I would like to take this opportunity to welcome your family to Salusbury Primary School. We are a warm, welcoming and very happy school at the heart of our community. It is our sincere hope that your child finds the transition from home to school as smooth as possible.
