Message from Mrs Huxham

There is lots of things happening this term, so please keep an eye on the dates to remember section and the website.

Next week is due to be very hot, please make sure you administer suncream to your child before they come to school. Please also provide a hat, cream and water bottle.

Just a reminder... If your child is ill and on medication the school can only administer medication subscribed by the doctor, with their name and dosage clearly labelled. We CAN NOT administer calpol unless prescribed by the doctor and the box has been labelled again with child's name and dosage. If you feel your child requires calpol, we are happy for you to come and administer it yourself.

PICKING UP YOUR CHILD

If you are late to collect your child, the procedure is as follows:

The child will be taken to the office if you are not here by 3.30pm the child will be placed in after school club, for which you will be charged, £4 per hour. If you are going to be late please contact the office before 3pm.

Please note there will be two important changes for you to remember **as from SEPTEMBER:**

1. As we are reverting to 4 classes, there is very little space in school, therefore every child will require a bookbag and we will not allow rucksacks to be brought to school as we do not have the cloakroom space to store them. You can buy a bookbag from Scholars in Trowbridge or Devizes for £7.50. If your child is in year 6 in September we do not expect you to buy a bookbag but please only bring a small bag. All PE kit is to be in a drawstring bag and not a rucksack.
2. For those of you who pay for wrap a round care and lunches, you will receive an invoice today for Term 5 and will receive an invoice for Term 6 in the last week. Please ensure you settle all invoices by the end of term and any outstanding monies. As of September in order to balance our books, we can not offer wrap a round care to anyone who has money outstanding. Also from September we will be accepting payments through parentmail. Please ensure all email addresses are correct with the office and download the parent mail app, if you have not already done so.
