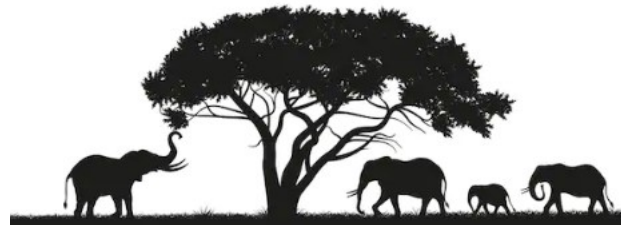
Spelling and grammar
