Year 1 Phonics Screening Check

At the end of Year 1 children complete a phonics check; this is to check the children's understanding of phonics (reading).

Key Stage 1 - 2017

At the end of Key Stage 1 (Year 2) children were previously expected to achieve a level 2B. The end of year outcomes are now reported as EXS – working at the expected standard for Year 2. GDS means the pupil is working in greater depth than the expected standard for Year 2

Key Stage 2

At the end of Key Stage 2 (Year 6) children were previously expected to achieve a level 4. The end of year outcomes are now reported as EXS – working at the expected standard for Year 6. GDS means the pupil is working in greater depth than the expected standard for Year 6.

Key Stage 2 average scaled scores

Year 6 pupils are now given a scaled score. This is derived from a raw score from the 3 tests taken:

- Reading
- Grammar, punctuation, vocabulary and spelling
- Maths

A scaled score ranges from 80 – 120. A score of more than 100 shows the pupil has met the expected standard in the test.
