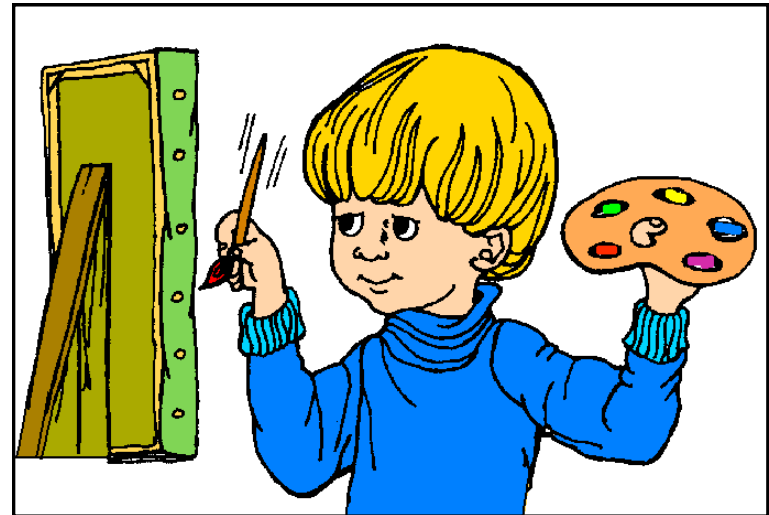
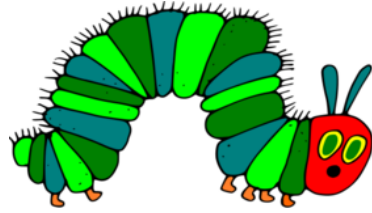


Foundation Stage

The topic for Foundation Stage this half term is 'Animal All-sorts'. The framework that the children follow in the Foundation Stage is outlined under 7 different areas of learning and is very creative. A large majority of the learning takes place through play and child initiated activities, therefore the activities may change throughout the week accordingly.

Communication and Language



- Listening to stories and poems about animals such as The Very Hungry Caterpillar
- Sharing own knowledge of animals
- Role play—travel agents/jungle

Reading and Writing

- Reading stories about animals
- Creating a leaflet about caring for animals
- Researching facts and writing a fact file
- Creating posters for role play safari trips
- Making up imaginary animals



Maths

- Recording favourite animals
- Talking about data and answering questions
- Identifying and using coins in the role play
- Exploring teen numbers
- Sharing and grouping
