We would like to work in **partnership** with you to support your child whilst school is closed. Home learning will consist of:

Core Learning Activities which will remain the same each week

Specific Weekly Learning Tasks focussing on English, maths and curriculum tasks; these will be updated on the school website each Friday.

Extra activities which are fun learning activities; children should aim to complete 2 a day.

We will try, where possible, to avoid the need for you to print out any resources.
