Week 1 8.1.18 Reflection:	SMART Attendance Presentation Safety Week Keeping Promises - Trust and Responsibility <i>It is easy to make promises to people; it is not always easy to keep those promises. If you made a promise, would people be able to trust you to keep that promise.</i>
Week 2 15.1.18 Reflection:	Truthfulness - Honesty and Responsibility Actions and Consequences <i>Our choices are important; they can affect us and others in the future. "Honesty is the best policy...or is it?"</i>
Week 3 22.1.18 Reflection:	Flood Week - why is it important to be prepared? "Say NO To Bullying" <i>Have you got the courage to help others who are being bullied, and to show friendship to those who are frightened and unhappy?</i>
Week 4 29.1.18 Reflection:	Making the right choices - making the right choice can affect our lives in all kinds of ways. <i>We all need to remember that making the right choices is important in our lives. Like the man who built his house on firm foundations, we need to think carefully about the choices we make.</i>
Week 5 5.2.18 Reflection:	International Day of Women in Science "Don't be afraid to ask!" To achieve, we need to make sure that we aren't afraid to ask. <i>Who will be wise enough to ask some good questions today? What is your big question for today?</i>

Spring Term B 2018 Theme - Mutual Respect

Week 1 19.2.18 Reflection:	Chinese New Year - Year of the Dog. Looking forward to the future. Respect, Honesty and Tolerance. <i>Chinese wish for the future - "May your happiness be as wide as the East Sea." Ask children to think about two things that they hope for their friends and family this year, and two good things that they hope for, for the world this year.</i>
Week 2 26.2.18 Reflection:	World Book Week Respect for others - respect and responsibility. <i>Mother Teresa said, "Let us always meet each other with a smile, for a smile is the beginning of love." Remember these words and try to share a friendly smile with everyone we meet today.</i>
Week 3 5.3.18 Reflection:	Mothering Sunday - Caring - Love, Compassion, Thankfulness. <i>Mothers' Day is the perfect opportunity to say "Thank You" to our mum/carer for looking after us, and loving us. Let's also think about the things that they do - comfort us when we are ad; give us advice when we aren't sure what to do; support us when we are unsure - are these things we could try and do for our friends and family?</i>
Week 4 12.3.18	Respect for God's Creation - respect and responsibility.

<p>Reflection:</p>	<p><i>How can you show you care today when inside school? Playing in the playground? At home and with your family? When you are in the community, in shops, in the park...? Encourage the children to reflect on how the wonder and beauty of the natural environment can be expressed through the arts.</i></p>
<p>Week 5 19.3.18 Reflection:</p>	<p>International Day of Happiness (20.3.18) Caring for the World and Everyone In It - mutual respect and responsibility. <i>Close your eyes and picture a day old chick in your hands - so light and chirpy; a baby rabbit in your hands - with furry coat and silky ears; a rosebud in your hands - so small and round and fragrant. The world is so big, we are so small. The world is like a jigsaw puzzle made up of tiny pieces. Each piece is needed - each plant, animal and person.</i></p>
<p>Week 6 26.3.18 Reflection:</p>	<p>Easter Story - Love, Tolerance, Hope and Forgiveness. <i>Think of a time when you were wrongly blamed for something. Look at the candle. One day the truth will come out. In the meantime, have courage and stay confident. As we think about the last week of Jesus' life, we consider the different reactions that ordinary people had towards Jesus during that time. How would you have reacted at this stage? What do you remember the most? The excitement of his arrival in Jerusalem? The anger and despair when he doesn't appear to be what we imagine a King to be? Joy because Jesus has kept his promise and come alive again? Think back over these feelings. Can you remember times when you have felt excited, angry or joyful?</i></p>
