Q3: Staff will be asked to talk to their children and ask them why they don't feel safe at break and lunchtimes.

Q4: Many children only play with their friends in their own year group so don't mix with the rest of the school.

Q7: Kenton Bar have just started to follow a Creative Curriculum - hopefully, this will engage the children.

Q13: A new Behaviour Policy is in place so hopefully when we survey the children again, this will have a more positive response.

Q14: We will be looking at Homework provision later in the year.

Q15: Golden Achievement Assembly takes place every Friday. We will ask the children to bring in any trophies / achievements that have taken place out of school each Friday so that they can be recognised. Will look at putting a form on the website so that parents can inform us of any out of school achievements.

Q23: A number of children felt they had been bullied over the past year but it is pleasing to see that they were able to tell a member of staff and that they felt the incident had been dealt with well. Assemblies and PSHE lessons will focus on Bullying during Spring A Term; plus, each class looked at Bullying during Anti-Bullying Week in November.

Q28: School Council meet weekly - Councillors will be asked to feed back to their class and, if appropriate, teachers will ask the children for their views to be fed back at the next meeting. Children's views are really important to us and we will address any issues / suggestions that arise.

Q30: It is pleasing to see that the majority of children think Kenton Bar is a good school and are proud to be a pupil here. 😊
