LITERACY

Writing

Practice forming lower-case letters correctly with attention equal size of letters within a word.

When writing segment spoken words into phonemes taught with increasing accuracy.

Writing News Recounts and non-fiction texts

Phonics/Spelling

Spell set 1 sight vocabulary words (Included in homework)

Revise and write phonic sounds from Year 1 to develop fluency in reading and increased accuracy in spelling.

Reading

Read texts daily in class, sounding out unfamiliar words more accurately.

Read sight vocabulary words for Year 2.

Group and 1:1 reading

MATHS

Addition and Subtraction

Recall addition bonds to 10 and 20 fluently

Add and subtract numbers; a two-digit number and ones, a two-digit number and tens,

Find out that addition of two numbers can be done in any order but subtraction of one number from another cannot.

Solve problems with addition and subtraction

Develop mental methods

2D and 3D shapes - link to topic on The Great Fire of London

ICT

Use computer software to create pictures relating out topic/English

Use Purple mash – word processing for topic

Begin to use simple code activities I pad applications e.g. Daisy the Dinosaur
