

Year 3 – Curriculum Information

English

Literature Works Text – The Lion, The Witch and The Wardrobe

Narrative – Classic Fiction/Adventure

- Explore different elements to story writing – describing characters and settings, problems and solutions.
- Write character and setting descriptions.
- Write own story based on elements of class text.
- Other writing opportunities linked to Literature Works text – character descriptions, grammar and punctuation work.
- Comprehension activities based on Literature Works text including hot seating, conscious alley, predictions, etc.



Maths

- Count in multiples of 0, 4, 8 50 and 100.
- Reinforce multiplication and division facts of the 2, 3, 4, 5, 8 and 10 times tables.
- Use mental and formal written methods to multiply and divide numbers (multiplication grid and long division).
- Solve problems involving multiplication and division, using methods above.
- Add and subtract amounts of money to give change, using both £ and p in practical contexts.

Science - Rocks

- Compare and sort rocks according to their appearance.
- To understand how a rock's formation affects its appearance.
- Learn different types of rocks.



History -- Ancient Greeks

- Explore differences between Greece and Ancient Greece.
- Explore life in Athens and Sparta.
- Learn about the beliefs of the Ancient Greek Gods.



Computing – Information Technology

- Understand how the internet works and how it can be accessed.
- Use search technologies effectively.
- Carry out topic related research.
- Appreciate how [search] results are selected and ranked.
- Carry out E safety around responsible searching, including images.

P.S.H.C.E – SEAL – Relationships

- Explore how to make people who are important to us happy.
- Express feelings of guilt and explain ways to make amends.
- Learn to take responsibility for actions and also tell someone if they have hurt their feelings.

RE – Expressions of Identity

- Discuss what is special about belonging.
- Explore how and why religious people show that they belong to a religion.
- Understand that the Bible is the Christian book of scripture which contains the foundation of teaching, guidance and worship.
- Understand that certain biblical passages have special significance for Christians.
