LITERACY

Writing

Continue to practice handwriting joins, with some joins seen within independent writing. Attention to appropriate size of letters is now important in preparation for KS2.

Exploration and review of writing genre inspired from Roald Dahl The Twits, Science Topic and Educational Visits

Grammar and Punctuation - Continue to develop the use of adjectives to describe nouns and adverbs to describe verbs. Use and/or/but or when/if/that/because to join clauses. Use question marks and exclamation marks.

Phonics/Spelling

Learn to spell Year 2 non-negotiable words- These are in your primary pathway booklets.
Continue to learn Year 2 spelling rules in weekly spellings.

Reading

Read class texts daily in class, increasingly reading without undue hesitation. Roald Dahl - The Twits
Continue to develop comprehension skills through discussion and written tasks
