**Literature Works Text – Into the Forest**

**Poems to perform**

- Read and discuss a range of performance poems.
- Identify features including repetition, alliteration, etc.
- Plan and write a poem with a pattern/rhythm.
- Perform and evaluate poems.
- Other writing opportunities linked to Literature Works text – character descriptions, grammar and punctuation work.
- Comprehension activities based on Literature Works text including hot seating, conscious alley, predictions, etc.

**Numeracy**

- Count in multiples of 0, 4, 8 50 and 100.
- Reinforce multiplication facts of the 2, 3, 4, 5, 8 and 10 times tables.
- Add and subtract numbers with up to three digits, using formal written methods of addition and subtraction.
- Use mental and formal written methods to multiple and divide numbers.
- Add and subtract amounts of money to give change, using both £ and p in practical contexts.
- Draw 2-D shapes and make 3-D shapes; recognise 3-D shapes in different orientations and describe them.
- Recognise angles as property of shape or a description of a turn.
- Identify right angles; identify whether angles are greater than or less than a right angle.
- Identify horizontal and vertical lines and pairs of perpendicular and parallel lines.
- Tell and write the time from an analogue clock.
- Interpret and present data using bar charts, pictograms and tables.

**Topic – Living and Growing**

- Identify and describe the functions of different parts of flowering plants.
- Explore the requirements of plants for life and growth and how they vary from plant to plant.
- Investigate the way in which water is transported within plants.
- Explore the part that flowers play in the life cycle of flowering plants, including pollination, seed formation and seed dispersal.

**I.C.T – Emails**

- Learn how to write clear and respectful messages.
- Learn to communicate effectively by email, taking into account the purpose and audience.
- Log onto an email account, open emails and send emails.
- Forward an email.
- Attach different files to emails, open and save attached files to appropriate places.

**P.S.H.C.E – SEAL – Relationships**

- Explore how to make people who are important to us happy.
- Express feelings of guilt and explain ways to make amends.
- Learn to take responsibility for actions and also tell someone if they have hurt their feelings.

- Learn about Hindu worship.
