Literacy

Our text this half term will be The Tiger who came to Tea

The children will:

- Sequence the stories and write about different characters in the stories.
- Complete non-fiction writing, focussing on tigers.
- Complete non-fiction writing through topic work on Minibeasts.
- Continue to re-enforce and apply word/sentence level skills.
- Through a variety of reading styles e.g. shared reading/guided reading/individual reading continue practising and reinforcing their skills.

Numeracy

- Develop understanding of multiplication using pictures objects and arrays.
- Continue work on fractions of shapes and numbers.
- Continue to develop mental skills by revising our non-negotiables daily.

Topic –Minibeasts

- This is a Science based topic and will involve the children completing outdoor practical activities.
- We shall investigate minibeasts and their habitats within our school grounds.
- We will look at the characteristics of minibeasts and complete sorting activities related to observable features.
- We will be looking at the different parts of an insect
- We will be looking at lifecycles and looking at caterpillars to butterflies and also continue our work on tadpoles to frogs

ICT

- Be able to log on to specific programmes used in school, and use the software available on these packages.
- Continue to develop and extend coding skills.

- The children are following a scheme called Zippy and his friends and the modules will be looking at: Module 5 Looking at change and Loss.
