I will be learning to...

- use the large apparatus in the hall during P.E. sessions and the large play equipment outside.
- move with confidence, control & safety
- draw and write using a triangulation grip.
- take part in 'Dough Disco' for my fine motor skill development
- use a range of tools safely e.g. scissors
- develop independence e.g. changing for P.E.

Literacy

I will be learning to...

- recognise, hear and enjoy rhyme.
- write my name clearly.
- learn letter sounds and blend and segment them.
- learn to recognise tricky words.
- tell stories, have them scribed and act them out in class.
- talk about stories and the characters in books
- enjoy writing for a purpose e.g. making lists, labelling models etc..

Understanding the World

I will be learning to...

- learn about different festivals and how they are celebrated e.g. Diwali, bonfire night, Christmas
- talk about my family and our family traditions e.g. firework night, Christmas.
- use the iPads and computer programmes to help me learn
- investigate and begin to understand things, places and people around me.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

I will be learning to...

- work with a variety of friends and learn what to do if we fall out.
- participate in turn taking games.
- listen to my friends ideas and think about their feelings.
- try new activities and select resources independently.
- discuss different feelings and emotions
- develop a 'growth mindset'.
- put on my own coat and do it up.
- talk about my part in the Christmas play.
