There is a proposal for a major train service cut for Hook. The MP Ranil Jayawardena has started a petition to try and stop this happening and he is needing as many signatures as possible before it is soon put to the House of Commons.

This will probably affect many, many parents who commute and this information may give you a chance to sign the petition if you wish. Its an issue that is irrelevant to the political party, but something that will affect all those living in Hook and in fact not just those that use the train for work to London but more local services, including students getting to Farnborough college and ultimately Hook itself.
