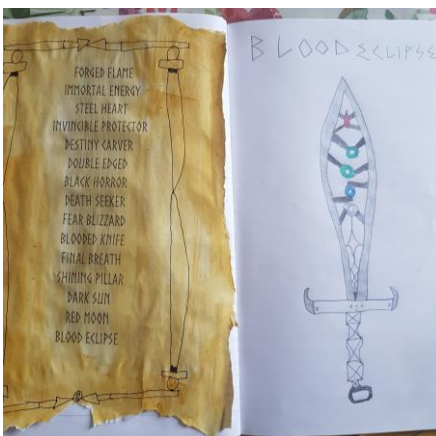
Sadly, at the moment, we do not yet know when we will all be able to be together again so we have to learn how to be patient, knowing that something wonderful will happen when the time is right.
