Year 5 will be magically transforming into their favourite character as they enter the World of Hogwarts.

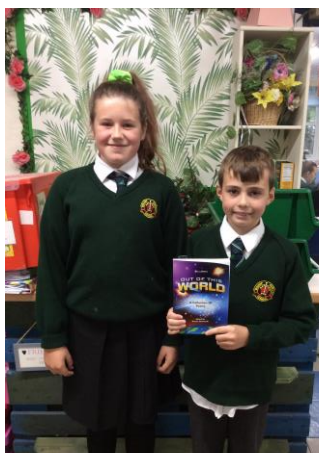
Year 6 will be studying and creating works of art in the style of Hans Holbein: King's Painter to King Henry VIII!
