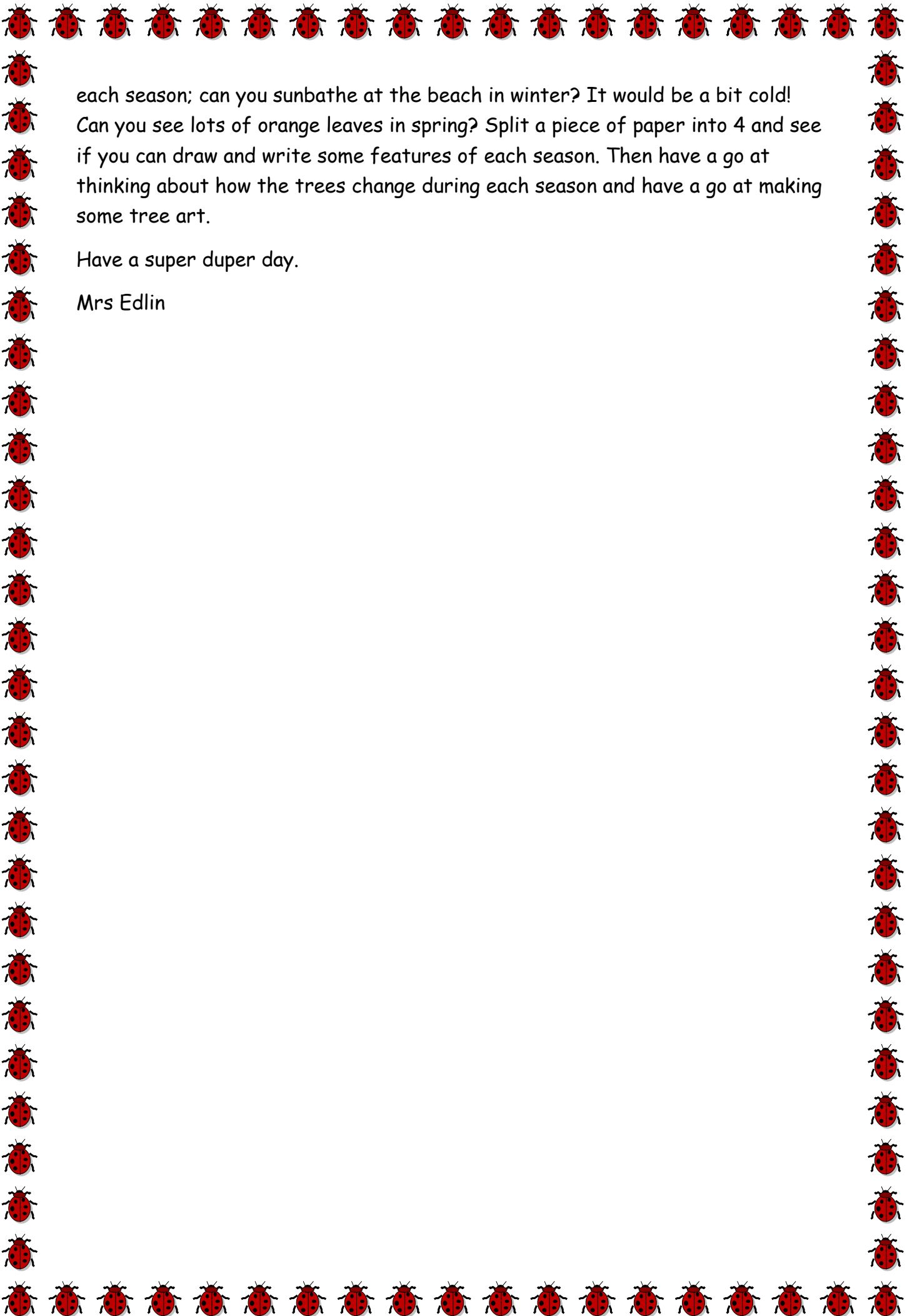

We are today going to think about the seasons. What do you already know about the 4 seasons? Can you remember what they all are? Let's think of different things we can do in

Can you see lots of orange leaves in spring? Split a piece of paper into 4 and see
if you can draw and write some features of each season. Then have a go at
thinking about how the trees change during each season and have a go at making
