<b>Number focus</b>	This week we would like you to log into your TTRockstars and play 'Garage' and 'Soundcheck'. (Give some facts for each one)</li> <li>- The Moon</li> <li>- The Sun</li> <li>- Why is there no gravity in space?</li> <li>- Have humans ever visited space? (Give examples)</li> </ul> Alternatively, you can design your own planet/solar system and create a "fact" file about it.
