







Homework tasks for Year 3

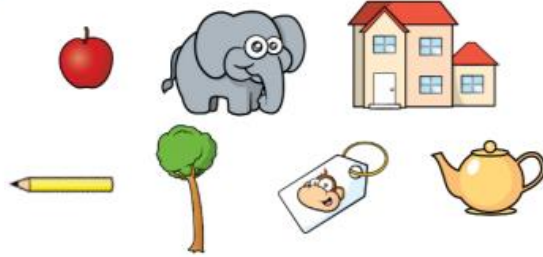
Week beginning 17.06.21
