



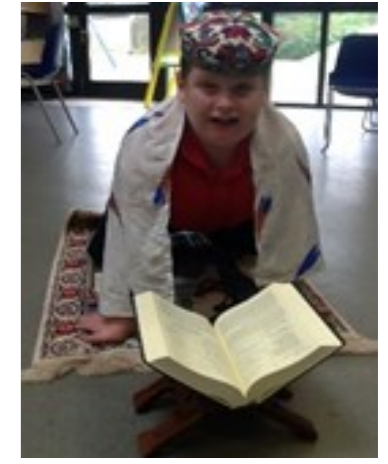
# Class 3


