## Pupil wellbeing

There are lots of ways school can help pupils who are experiencing any issues that may affect their wellbeing:



### ELSA (Emotional Literacy Support Assistant)

Mrs Brown, our ELSA trained Teaching Assistant, has worked with lots of pupils this term to support their wellbeing. She works one to one with pupils and shares stories and activities to promote self-esteem, deal with issues such as parents separating, anxiety, anger and other emotions. The aim is to give pupils a bit of 'me' time and a safe space to explore how they are feeling and positive strategies to cope. Mrs Brown has now shared her work and resources with all of our Teaching Assistants in all Key Stages so that we can support more pupils. ### Supernanny\ My School Health

Jane, our school nurse, comes every fortnight and is open to appointments to support parents and pupils with many issues including: behaviour, ASD, bedtimes, toilet training, anxiety. Please complete the form below or speak Mrs Bruce if you would like an appointment.



Our Safeguarding Schools liaison officer, Karen Kirkbride, is coming to do a friendship and relationships PSHE session with year one. This is part of our work with Northumberland police in partnership to safeguard pupils against future domestic abuse, with early intervention.

There will be a drop in session where parents can speak with Karen to seek advice regarding domestic abuse, request an onward referral to domestic abuse support services or alternatively make a report to the Police. This will take place at **8:30am on Wednesday 8th January 2020**. Please call in on that date at 8:30am - no appointment necessary or alternatively let Mrs Bruce know you would like to speak to Karen.



Our Teaching Assistants are also trained to deliver 'Rainbows.' This is a weekly programme for a small group of pupils who are coping with loss. This could be bereavement, or a parent separation. This programme will run in the Spring Term in small Key Stage groups.
