They are currently delivering this club once a week but still require support from Miss Hexter. They are not currently confident enough to replace our existing provision. We are currently continuing to use TGS coaching services.

Train sports ambassadors to lead a C4L club i.e. multiskills during a lunch time under the supervision of an adult.	88 pupils (25% of current number on roll) have represented the school. We have attended 12 competitions, including 2 C4L events. More events are planned for the summer term, including an inclusive event. Sports ambassadors are delivering a multi-skills club once a week. Through both external and school-run clubs, children have the opportunity to attend 10 different afterschool or lunchtime sporting

			clubs. 107 (30%) children attend these clubs.

All Yr 5 and Yr 6 children to take part in Bikeability. Will achieve either Level 1 or Level 2 Proficiency badges. Provide an all -weather facility to maximize participation in physical activity (by 2020).	All teachers have been given access to Class Yoga and Year 5 had an introductory session. Timetabling prevented a club being started, however some teachers are using the Class Yoga resources in the classroom. Bikeability booked for the summer term for Year 6. Timetabling prevented Year 5 taking part as well; this is a target for next year. Quotes have been sourced for a cover for the orchard, but logistics are still being worked out.
