Great Gaddesden C of E School will receive a Covid-19 catch up premium, of £80 per pupil, during the 2020-21 academic year. This funding will be used to support children in order for them to catch up on the learning over the course of the pandemic.

The Education Endowment Foundation published guidance on how this funding should be used, recommending a three-tiered strategy, focusing on:

1. Teaching (supporting teaching, pupil assessment and feedback, transition support)
2. Targeted academic support (1:1, small group teaching + support, intervention programmes, extended school time)
3. Wider strategies (including supporting parents and carers, access to technology and summer support)

In Great Gaddesden School, we are undertaking informal baseline assessments of all children on return to school in March '21.

This enables us to implement the most effective actions to support all the children in their learning.

The following strategies will be implemented within our school :-
