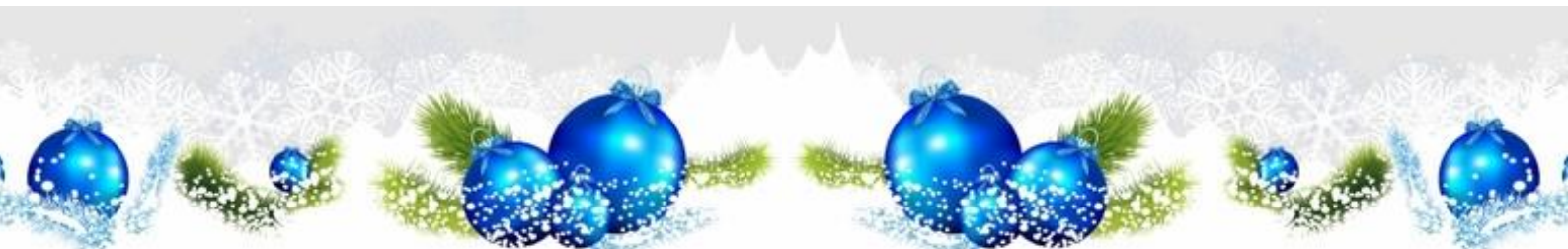
A Big Thank you to Devoran School for making Christmas cards for the community you've brought smiles to so many peoples faces, Happy Christmas
