Uganda

Hello, my name is Izzy and in July 2019 I am going to Uganda on a 3 week educational / working trip with my school - Richard Lander ['RLS'].

Each year RLS take a group of year 10 students to help the Molly and Paul Foundation. This is a charity which runs 3 primary schools, 2 secondary schools, a farm school and 3 orphanages.

Prior to going to Uganda, the 2019 team will work together to raise monies to buy much-needed essential supplies and equipment for the Molly & Paul Foundation when we are there. Our priority is to make a big difference to them all.

For example:

We will help build additional toilet blocks or accommodation blocks, as more and more children are joining the orphanages to attend the schools & so require the accommodation too.

Each year the 'Lander to Uganda' team carry out a much needed 'bra drop', which is when we take second hand bras from the UK, to give to all the women in the outlying communities (by simply wearing a bra, makes the women less desirable' for rape!)

We are also tasked to paint the outside of the schools to make them look a happier place to learn in, paint murals on the inside walls – both to encourage their learning and give hope and help teach some of the lessons, whilst we are there.

We have additional projects to work on whilst we are there, which has been pre-arranged between our RLS Teachers and the Head of the Molly and Paul Foundation.

I have challenged myself to work to raise the cost of the trip myself. (£2500)

I can work for you too - to help you with the following:

- Baby-Sitting
- Clean your car (inside and out – or just the outside)
- Clean your house (vacuum, clean bathrooms, polish etc) I already help 'chambermaid' for my Mum's Air BnB rooms
- Walk your dog(s) / groom your dog(s) etc
- Clean out rabbit / guinea pig cages
- Help you in the garden
- Or any other job you think I can help you with
