Further to the announcements and congratulations made in the welcome back newsletter early September, we would like to personally congratulate you and your staff on your 2019 summer results.

We were very pleased to see that based on the 2019 provisional data the outcomes for your school are:

- 1) In the top quartile at KS1 in all three measures and, outcomes are above the Essex average for combined reading, writing and maths at KS2*
- 2) In the top quartile at KS2 in all three attainment measures (reading, writing and maths)
- 3) The percentage of children meeting the required level at Phonics at the end of Year 1 is above the national average and your school is in the top quartile for performance for this measure.

We know that achieving high standards and significant improvement with children is very demanding and this is due to the hard work of your staff. This in turn, has further embedded the depth and breadth of excellence shown in the Primary school sector in Essex.
