



<p><u>Science</u> Children will be learning all about plants. We will be naming common plants and trees and labelling their different parts. We will learn all about what the different parts of the plant does and will understand what a plant needs to grow.</p>	<p><u>Maths</u> Children will continue to develop a range of skills in addition, subtraction, multiplication, division, shape, fractions and measures. They will focus on developing their fluency and reasoning skills in maths. We will also be practising our 2, 3, 5 and 10 times tables.</p>	<p><u>Religious Education</u> Children will be learning about Judaism.
