Welcome to the start of a new term! It is hard to believe that we are already over half way through the academic year! This term is going to have a very sporty feel as we get ready to support the national fundraising event - Sports Relief.

### Sports Relief

This year, the children at Plumpton Primary school will be running to Kenya for Sports Relief – which takes place from Monday 19<sup>th</sup> March until Friday 23<sup>rd</sup> March. The total distance is a massive 4000 miles! Don't panic, we won't literally be running to Kenya, so passports are not required! Instead, sports coach Mr Munnery and HLTA Mrs Taplin have planned an entire week's worth of physical activity for the children and staff to participate in. Activities will include running, skipping and circuits. Each class will complete a series of 15 minute sessions throughout the day. Due to the popularity of skipping throughout the school, Mr Munnery has also arranged a skipping workshop on the Tuesday of this week. Your child will be bringing home a sponsorship form to help raise money for this very worthwhile charitable event, therefore, thank you in advance for all your support! 
