School continues to be very busy this term and the children are working very hard. It has been lovely to see so many of you at our recent class assemblies, and we hope you enjoyed watching them as much as the children enjoyed performing them!

Kingfisher Class Trip to Portsmouth

Kingfisher Class had a fantastic day at Portsmouth Historic Dockyard this Tuesday. They visited the HMS Victory and took part in an Elizabethan Explorers Education session. The children were particularly lucky too, as they also saw the HMS Queen Elizabeth aircraft carrier (which happened to be in Portsmouth on the same day). The Kingfishers were therefore able to compare, first-hand, the differences between the HMS Victory (circa 1760) and the HMS Queen Elizabeth (circa 2017). The day linked perfectly to our topic of trade and the children learnt a lot about how sea trade has developed over the centuries (from early explorers, to the slave trade, to modern-day fair trade).



Forest School

This term, the Year 5 children are enjoying forest school as part of the science curriculum. Plumpton parent Mr Mark Gilbert has planned a range of exciting activities which not only meet the expectations of the upper Key Stage Two curriculum, but are enabling the children to work towards achieving the John Muir Award (a national environmental award scheme which encourages people to connect with, enjoy and care for wild places). We are very lucky to have such a provision and the response from the children has been very positive!



Open Morning

We had a very busy Open Morning and welcomed over a dozen sets of parents to our school. The Year 6 children did a superb job of showing the parents around and looked very smart for the occasion – well done Year 6! 
