Special Educational Needs Impact Statement.

At Padstow School, we closely monitor the impact of all of our pupils with special educational needs to ensure that they are making good progress towards expected educational outcomes.

In 2017-18, there were 49 children identified within the school as having special educational needs. These pupils were supported in a variety of ways, including 1-1 support, additional teaching time, access to learning aids and resources, additional parental support and external services.

We know that this additional support was effective because these pupils made good progress compared to their peers.
