Defiance and unacceptable behaviours	Pupil is sent to partner class and this is reported to a member of the Senior Leadership Team (SLT)	Headteacher and parents are informed of this. The class teacher will contact parents to inform them of this process. Parents will be shown the 'School- home behaviour agreement'
Repetitive defiant and unacceptable behaviours.	Removal from class and other daily routines (including lunchtimes, playtimes, school trips and outdoor classroom)	Parents will be called in for a meeting with class teacher, this is to ensure all behaviour strategies at home and school are consistent. A member of Senior Leadership Team will be informed of outcome. A follow up meeting will be arranged (2 weeks' time)
<p>If issues are persistent, support strategies will be offered to parents in the form of:-</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A phone call top come in and support your child in school (if behaviour has reached unacceptable and unsafe level) • Referral to our Nurture Coordinator • Bespoke parenting classes offered, with expectation that they will be attended. • External agencies involvement (School Nurse/Education Psychologist/Behaviour Support) • Behaviour Care Plan set up in school • Individual risk assessments completed • Involvement from Senior Leadership Team
