

Maths Recovery Curriculum

Teachers will be reviewing missed learning opportunities in maths from the previous academic year, combined with current objectives to be taught within this autumn term.

This will be driven by the White Rose learning approach as this identifies key features to support with recapping learning objectives and missed maths areas; in conjunction with current objectives. This approach enables learners to embed previous knowledge and to gain more knowledge and confidence in areas that may have been missed.

Following the recovery and recap approach from White Rose, children will still be working hard on their arithmetic and problem solving development weekly.

In addition, children will begin to increase their problem solving and reasoning skills weekly in specific problem solving and arithmetic lessons.
