

Moorlands Junior School 2017 Key Stage 2 SATs Results

66 pupils were eligible to sit the national tests, therefore each child equates to approximately 1.5%.

The Whole School results below include the seven Year 6 children that were taught within our Small Specialist Class. We host this resource for pupils across Trafford who have a Statement/EHC Plan for Special Educational Needs. It is not appropriate for these children to sit the SATS tests. In 2017, as there were seven Year 6 pupils in our SSC, this equates to 10.5%.

Whole School – 66 pupils (59 mainstream + 7 SSC) (1 child = 1.5%)
