Letters have been given out to the children.

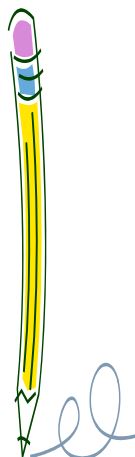
Bikeability

There will now be an additional date for a fourth session on Friday 8th December.

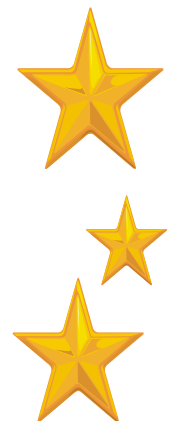
