Raffle

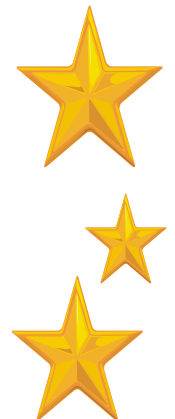
Some of our children have been running a raffle to raise money for the playground development.
