The online booking system for the parents' evenings is now open. If you are experiencing any problems, please contact Mrs Axis in the school office.

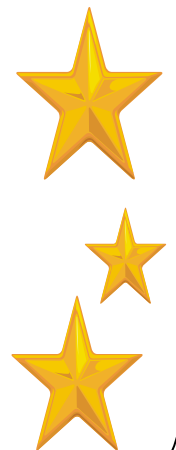
