At Andoversford Primary School, we use a cursive (joined) handwriting style. Children learn to write the letters using the cursive formation, and then once they are ready they begin to join. We value presentation and aim to make sure that all work is completed to a high standard. When pupils achieve this standard, they will receive a pen licence.

Points to remember:

- Capital Letters are not joined.
- All lower-case letters start with a feeder-leader flick from the line.
- Most letters join the next letter from the line, but some letters use a table-top join.
