Dear Parent/Carers,

Below is a few gentle reminders;

Lost Property

From time to time children may lose or misplace an item of their uniform. Parents are reminded that all uniform, coats/jackets **must** be clearly marked with your child's name. It is extremely difficult for lost property to be returned to its rightful owner if there is no name inside. If your child accidentally brings another child's clothing home with them can we ask that this be returned to school as soon as possible. Thank you.

As the warmer weather approaches lots of children take off their sweaters and cardigans at break times/lunchtimes as you can imagine these sometimes get mixed up so please make sure that your child has their name clearly marked in their uniform.

PE Kits

Please remember PE kit **must** come into school each Monday and taken home on a Friday to be washed. PE is part of our school curriculum and all children must take part.

As the weather is getting warmer could you please make sure your child has their trainers in school as we will be having our PE lessons outside Thankyou.

Shoes/trainers.

May I please remind parents that boots/trainers **cannot** be worn in school please ensure that your child is wearing black or brown school shoes.

School Photographs

On Monday 20th May, Focal Point photographers will be in school to take a class photograph of our Reception and Year 6 children. Parents can purchase photos and see how their child grows throughout their primary school years. This is also a great memento for our Year 6 parents to keep. Focal Point will send a proof to school, which will then be sent home with your child.

Emergency contact numbers.

Please can you ensure that the office has up to date contact details, especially when mobile phones are changed.

Please can you check your telephone regularly in case of emergency.

Dinner Money.

Can I please remind parents that if your child has a paid school meal, dinner money **must** come into school on a Monday morning. Banking is done on a Monday and it is too time consuming for staff to have to feed in money after this stage.

If money does not come in on a Monday you will be asked to provide a packed lunch from home for the rest of the week. Thank you.
