- Maintain efficient systems so that information reaches you promptly and contact details are kept up to date.
- Ensure that school premises are clean and hygienic for all to use.
- Make available all relevant school policies, for information, from the school office.

The parents/carers will:

- Explain to the child the meaning of the agreement and sign.
- Reinforce the schools expectations of excellent behaviour.
- Encourage children to resolve difficulties in a positive, appropriate way.
- Speak to the class teacher or head teacher if they are concerned about their child.
- Be positive towards their child and his/her achievements.
- Consent and support to the Academy's vision and mission.
- Send your child to school fit and well every day and on time. If they are absent, phone to let us know why and provide a letter on their return.
- Make sure your child adheres to the school's uniform rules at all times.
- Read with your child regularly and comment in their reading record.
