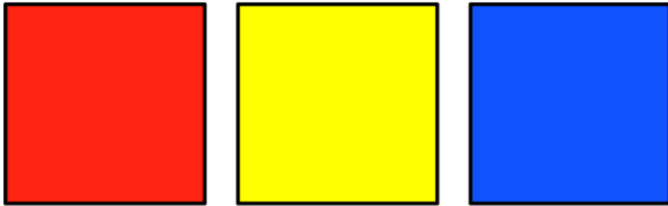


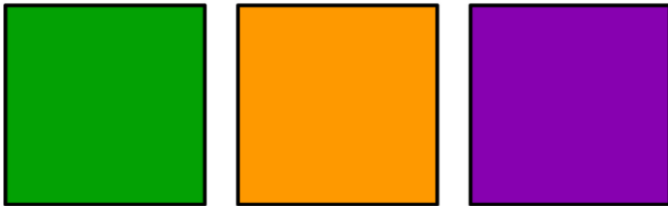

Paul Klee (18 December 1879 – 29 June 1940) was a Swiss-German artist. He was one of the most famous painters of the 20th century. His work was influenced by Expressionism, Cubism, and Surrealism. He was also very interested in the theory of colour.



A person who creates paintings or drawings as a profession or hobby.

The light that we see is made up of many different colours.

There are three primary colours: red, green and blue. They can be combined in different ways to make every other colour.

Colour charts show us how colours are related. They remind artists how to mix and think about colours.
