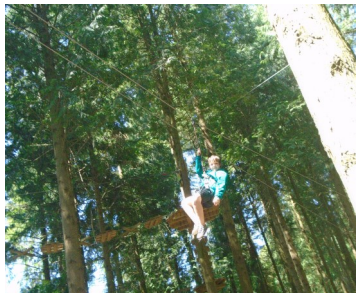
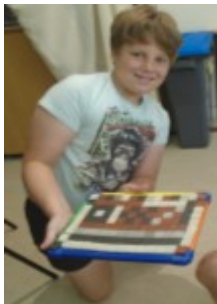
KS2 Sports Day
