Thank you for your continued patience and understanding as we continue to work together through this unprecedented situation. We have been working as a school to create online resources that can be accessed at home in order to continue your children's learning.

Google Classroom

The work that we will provide for your child will be on Google Classroom. This is a free, web-based service developed by Google, which can be accessed from any device that has internet access (E.g. Smart phone, tablet, laptop, PC etc.).

If your child is currently in school today, they will have been shown how to log in. The process for this is slightly different from home and we have therefore attached a *How To Guide*, which also explains login names and passwords. If your child has not been in school, please follow the steps in the How To Guides attached. If you are experiencing problems logging in, please email admin@st-margarets-junior.devon.sch.uk and we will respond as soon as possible.

Teachers will be posting work daily which you can access and submit electronically. Teachers will also be posting links and resources on the Year Group's Stream (which is similar to a wall on Facebook).

School Website

Each year group has also provided a selection of work on the school website, which children in isolation have been accessing prior to schools closing. This can be accessed through finding the Curriculum Page for your child's year group at www.st-margarets-junior.devon.sch.uk/web. These will not continue to be updated. As from Monday 23rd we will be posting our work on Google Classroom.

Resources

We will be providing each child with an exercise book for them to use at home. This can be used if children wish to practise handwriting, spellings, or wish to do their work on paper. We are not expecting work to be printed off, or for books to be handed in when schools reopen.

If you have any questions or concerns, please remember that the school is still staffed and you are welcome to ring the school for advice. We may not always be able to answer the phone, but please leave a message and we will get back to you.
