



This will be a real gallery where parents will have the opportunity to purchase their child's masterpiece for a suggested donation of £1. This money will be used towards the cost of resources used during Art Week.

In addition to Art Week, over the course of the next few weeks, we are going to revamp the hall by displaying our **key school values** (respect, resilience, pride etc.) on large lettering cut from wood, which the children will decorate using a range of different techniques (*clay, ink, mod roc, finger painting, art straws, paints, paper, water colours, sponge printing, pencils, tissue paper, charcoal, mosaics etc.*). These will be displayed permanently on the hall walls as a reminder of our school values which will also help improve the aesthetics of the hall environment.

We are sure everyone at Brookfield will enjoy our Arts week, so please come and join us on the given dates and share this amazing curriculum event with us.
