Dear Families,

How can you help your child if they are experiencing a problem with another child?

Please come and speak to your child's class teacher and let us help you to resolve the problem. We would ask that parent's do not try to talk to other children directly about any issues that have occurred. We know that the best way to resolve an issue is through working with staff that they know and trust. Thank you.

Reminders

If you have signed a consent form for your child to have paracetamol during the school day, please can we remind you that this will only be given if your child becomes unwell during their time at school and a first aider decides that your child needs it. If you think your child will need paracetamol at lunchtime because they are unwell in the morning, then you are welcome to pop in and administer it to your child, alternatively if you require us to administer it on your behalf then please provide us with your own supply of age appropriate liquid paracetamol.

We are still awaiting outstanding data collection forms, Flu vaccination letters, asthma forms and care plans. Can you please return this as a matter of urgency. Flu vaccinations' will not take place if we do not have the written consent. If you require further copies of any of these forms please pop into the school office.

Please be aware that parents should not be driving into school to collect their child. Only people with blue badges or prior arrangement's are allowed to drive onto school premises'. If your child attends an 8am club, please refrain from dropping them off any earlier than 8am as the staff running these clubs are not on site until this time.
