Homework Help!

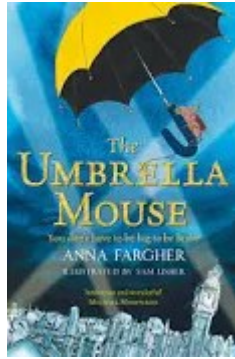

We are delighted to inform you that the Year-5 Chatterbooks groups have won a competition organised by MacMillan Publishers to read and review a book, 'The Umbrella Mouse' by Anna Fargher, a new children's author. The book draws on the true stories of animals caught up in the conflict of WWII and is beautifully illustrated. Reminders

General uniform reminders

No jewellery except small **plain stud** earrings are allowed to be worn in school. These must be removed for PE or covered with tape if recently pierced.

Hair must be tied up if beyond collar length, only small hairclips/bands and bows for the purpose of holding the hair in place in school uniform colours may be worn.

Paracetamol

Please be aware that we only keep a small amount of liquid paracetamol in school. This is only to be used in an emergency if your child becomes unwell during the school day. If your child needs regular paracetamol for cold, injury etc then we would request that you either pop in and administer the medicine yourself or leave your own supply at school.

Christmas Dinner day

All children in YR, 1 and 2 are entitled to a free Universal hot school dinner on our Christmas dinner day (Tuesday 17th December) if you want your child to receive one of these then please complete the form sent out via school Ping before Monday 2nd December. If we do not receive your order through Ping by this date we will be unable to order a meal and you will need to provide your child with a packed lunch.

KS2 Panto

Please can we remind all parents from KS2 that we need the consent form and payment for 'Cinderella'. Please see your original Ping message to complete this. If you have any trouble with Ping then please do not hesitate to contact the school office.

Parking
