



Governor's Impact Statement

The governors have responsibility for the governance of the school. They are responsible for setting the overall objectives and ethos of the school, and they ensure that the school is properly managed. The governor's have had a positive impact on the school in 2016/17 as evidenced by the following impact measures:

- Supported the SLT in developing a school based nursery offer
- Worked with the wider leadership team through governor visits and reports to the local governing body to improve pupil standards and outcomes
- Leaders and governors jointly evaluated the impact of the marking policy to ensure consistency and increased pupil engagement in their learning
- Supported the school to further improve pupil's enjoyment of reading and their reading stamina through the investment in the Accelerated Reader scheme
- Support the retention of the Family Support Advisor in response to contextual challenges and to continue to meet the needs of vulnerable children and families
- Reviewed the school policy on support for curriculum related trips and visitors to ensure high pupil participation to facilitate the delivery of a broad and balanced curriculum
- Challenge and hold the school to account for the impact of Pupil Premium and Sports Premium spending to raise standards through meetings with Senior Leaders, Progress Leaders, Governor Visits and reports to governors.
