Dear Parents,

I am delighted that we are able to offer the following clubs for the Summer term - see overleaf. Have a careful look and work out which club/s your child would like to take part in.

When will they start?

Clubs will run for 10 weeks. They will start the week of Monday 23rd April, with the last week being week beginning 2nd July. The exception to this is the KS2 sewing club which will be 2 groups of 5 weeks as they have to be smaller groups. Please book for Sewing Club 1 or 2 (not both).

How much will they cost?

All clubs will cost £2 per week (£20 for the term/£10 for sewing).

How do I book/pay?

Booking must be made on Parentpay and payment is made at the same time. All bookings must be done by Friday 20th April.

Where do parents collect their children?

From outside the front entrance. If your child is being collected by someone other than the usual adult, please let Mrs Bidecant know. Please note most afterschool clubs finish at 4.15pm. The exceptions are: choir at 4pm, KS1 football at 4.30pm and computer club at 4.45pm.

Computer Club v2.0

This carries on from the last Computer Club, but uses a BBC micro:bit instead of a Mover and the students will get their own equipment to keep. We will be using click-drag-edit blocks of code to write javascript, creating games, applications, interact with connected accessories and even remotely control a robot. This is challenging, so having completed Computer Club in the Autumn term is a pre-requisite; any empty spaces will then be open to Years 5 and 6.
